

## **Siluria Baptist Church Alabaster, Alabama Student Pastor**

Principal function: The student pastor will supervise ministry to middle-school, high school and college and career youth, seeking to encourage them to meaningful faith in Christ.

Qualifications: The student pastor will give evidence of a vital faith and active involvement in a like-minded church. He will furthermore give evidence of God's call to this ministry.

Requirements:

1. The student pastor will be recommended to the congregation by the Church Administration Committee and will begin service following church approval. Financial compensation will be included as part of the initial recommendation.
2. The student pastor will be a member of Siluria Baptist Church and will report to the pastor. He shall also be part of the Church Council.
3. He will be supportive of church leadership and programming and attend all scheduled worship and study times in so far as possible due to the part-time status of his position.
4. The student pastor will seek to present a positive Christian testimony to all young people, seek to bring as many youth as possible to Christ and his church and involve them in discipleship.
5. He will direct the church's outreach to unsaved youth and seek to involve the church's youth group in outreach.
6. He will work with the Student Ministry Committee and include members of this committee in activities as chaperones and mentors for the youth, also being diligent not to be alone with youth in accord with the church's child protection policies.
7. He will be involved in youth Sunday School, encouraging attendance and growth in the classes involved.
8. He will customarily teach the Wednesday night youth class.
9. He will plan ministry and recreational activities for the church's young people, coordinating all activities with the Student Ministry Committee and calendaring through the church office.
10. He will submit an annual budget request to the Budget and Finance Committee for inclusion in the church budget, seeking the advice and support of the Student Ministry Committee in budget planning.
