- **Open NOW** - Serve Tour project request submission
- **November 19, 2025** - Deadline to submit projects for the Birmingham Serve Tour
- **February 4, 2026** - Registration for specific projects goes live
- **March 20 - 21, 2026** - Serve Tour Birmingham

Serve Tour Project Ideas

1. Find creative ways to meet a **need or show Christ's love to the local community**. Some groups to serve include: foster families, first responders, the homeless, nurses, chaplains, or refugees.
2. **Ask city leaders what the needs are** within the city that volunteers could help with. This creates an opportunity to build relationships with city leaders.
3. **Serve local schools** by asking administration how we can love on teachers and students. Some ideas include: paint the teachers lounge, create a resource closet for children in need of hygiene items and school supplies, and host an appreciation event for bus drivers.
4. **Host events** that will create opportunities for connection. Examples: block party, sports camp, backyard bible club, etc.
5. **Host a neighborhood grill walk**. Volunteers take a grill hooked up to a van or truck and walk through apartment complexes or trailer parks to offer free burgers and prayer.
6. **Upgrades/maintenance needs** for a church building going through revitalization.
7. Bless a **bi-vocational pastor**.
